Classes of Music

Air (slow or lively), March, Jig (Double, Single, Slip Jig), Polka, Slide, Hornpipe, Reel or Set Dance

Beginner Solos – intended for musicians 18 years old and under, who are new to their instrument (playing less than 18 months). Competitors will play one tune from any class.

Open Solos – Open to any musician of the appropriate age group.

Under 10 – one tune from any class,

U11-U15 – play 2 tunes (each from a different music class),

U16 and over – play 3 tunes (each from a different music class)

1. Only traditional Irish music and traditional Irish instruments will be accepted in all competitions. Acceptable instruments include fiddle, flute/tinwhistle, accordion, melody piano (bring keyboard), harp and miscellaneous category (hammered dulcimer, tenor banjo, mandolin, cello, uilleann pipes, concertina, ect.).
2. A satisfactory standard is necessary for awarding first or any other prize.
3. Competitors who do not present themselves when their competition is called may be disqualified. Every effort will be made to accommodate time conflicts for dancing competitors. Please let registration table know of conflicts.
4. Miscellaneous instruments are instruments that are not listed as specific instruments.
